**CCWD TO FLUSH MAIN WATER LINES IN THE
COPPEROPOLIS SERVICE AREA**

CALAVERAS COUNTY WATER DISTRICT will be flushing water lines in its Copper Cove Water System, which includes Lake Tulloch Shores, Poker Flat, Conner Estates, Saddle Creek, Copper Cove Units 1-8A, Copper Meadows and the Copperopolis townsite, intermittently from Nov. 27, 2006 through Jan. 31, 2007. During flushing of main lines, water customers may experience low water pressure and/or slightly discolored water, which is not harmful to health. It is also normal for large amounts of water to flow into streets and gutters. CCWD will place informational signs in areas being flushed. When signs are posted it is recommended that customers refrain from washing clothes, as flushing may draw discolored water into lines and stain clothing. Low water pressure and water conditions should return to normal within a few hours of flushing activities. If the water is discolored allow a faucet to run until the water runs clear.
