CRITICAL FACILITY GENERATOR IMPLEMENTATION PROJECT

The Calaveras County Water District (CCWD) invites bids from qualified and experienced Generator and Appurtenance Vendors (prospective bidders) to furnish the equipment (Generators, Automatic Transfer Switches) and Material (fencing, pre-fabricated concrete pads) necessary to complete its Critical Facility Generator Implementation Project (Project). CCWD Crews will install the equipment and materials.

Prospective bidders shall provide Sealed Bids to CCWD for the following:

- Six (6) 40Kw Stationary Diesel-Powered Generators
- One (1) 80Kw Stationary Diesel-Powered Generator
- One (1) 15Kw Stationary Diesel-Powered Generator
- Two (2) 20Kw Stationary Diesel-Powered Generators
- Ten (10) Applicable and Compatible Automatic Transfer Switches

This Project is funded (75%) by FEMA's Hazard Mitigation Grant Program. It is subject to Federal Procurement Methods (2 CFR 200.320) Section b.1, *Formal Procurement Methods, Sealed Bids*.
